Guinness World Record was set by the College on 31/01/2024, for collecting the most number of plastic bottles for recycling in 12 hours in association with Bisleri International Private Limited, Mumbai.

1. Library

The college library is housed in an independent building with a total area of 24,200 sq.ft., designed to provide a conducive environment for academic pursuits. It boasts a rich collection of over 1,51,657 volumes of books and 351 journals, covering diverse disciplines in arts, sciences, social sciences, and humanities. In addition to books and journals, the library holds non-book materials such as audio cassettes, video cassettes, and CD-ROMs. A dedicated Digital Library with 60 computers is available for accessing a wide range of electronic resources, including ScienceDirect, Scopus, EBSCO, CMIE-Prowess IQ, CAPITALINE AWS, INDIASTAT, DELNET, EPWRF - India Time Series, Knimbus (a unified e-library platform offering remote access to subscribed and selected open access e-journals, e-books, and databases), Edzter (digital access to online magazines, newspapers, and journals), New Age International e-Books, EPW Digital Edition. The library is equipped with advanced statistical and research software tools, including SPSS v28, SPSS with Amos v28, EViews 13, Stata SE 18, Grammarly, NVivo 15, Citavi, SmartPLS, XLStat Basic. Library operations are fully automated using KOHA open-source software. Integration of RFID technology, including a Self-Service Kiosk and Drop Box, ensures efficient access to library materials and enhances security. An SMS alert service notifies users about check-in, check-out, renewals, overdue, and pre-due reminders. The library provides Inter- Library Loan (ILL) services via DELNET, and Web OPAC allows users to search and access the collection remotely. Special facilities such as Read Easy software, NVDA (Nonvisual Desktop Access) Screen Reader are available for students with disabilities (visually impaired). A dedicated Competitive Exam Study Centre has been established to support Civil Services and other Competitive Exam aspirants.

The library has also implemented the IRINS (Indian Research Information Network System) for faculty profile management. This platform is integrated with academic identifiers such as ORCID ID, Scopus ID, Researcher ID, Microsoft Academic ID, and Google Scholar ID, enabling seamless consolidation of scholarly publications.

2. Sports

The College accentuates on extra-curricular activities of the students. To facilitate the students to develop their abilities in sports and games the College has an Indoor Auditorium with a playing area of 20, 666 sq feet, encompassing Basketball, Badminton and Volleyball Courts. There are separate playgrounds for Football, Handball, Kho-Kho and Ball-Badminton. The College has flood - lit Basketball, Volleyball and Tennis Courts (Synthetic). The College runs a health club.

3. Gymnasium

The Gym is housed in 4,400 sq.ft. space with world class equipment and air-conditioned halls. It has 6 treadmills (C954i), 4 Elliptical (EFX 534), 2 Recumbent (C842i), 2 Upright bikes (C240), Stretch Trainers and 14 Strength Equipments (Individual Stations). The Gym has separate restrooms and locker facilities for men and women. The gym has separate areas for cardio, free weights and aerobics.

4. Manavar Manram

Student council known as Manavar Manram is a democratic set-up, which supports the management in all students welfare aspects. Manavar Manram along with clubs, forums and department associations serve as a platform for developing the skills of individuals, in curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. For enable easy reach-out to students, there are two separate Manrams for aided courses and self-financed programmes. ManavarManrams enhance the students's talents, leadership skills, team spirit, organizing abilities and competitive spirit. ManavarManrams organize meetings every month to discuss and resolve the grievances of the students.

5. NCC & NSS Units

Four NSS and four NCC units function in the College to develop students & social awareness, social involvement, social responsibility, discipline and leadership qualities.

6. Career Development Center

The Career Development Center (CDC) at PSG College of Arts & Science helps students develop competencies, explore professional interests, and map them to diverse career choices. Through its comprehensive Skill Enhancement & Employability Development (SEED) Program, the CDC offers meticulously structured training in soft-skills, aptitude,

7. Centre for HOPE (Helping Our People Excel)

Centre for HOPE was established to ensure psychological and emotional well-being of the PSGCAS community.

This centre continues to assist students through individual and group counseling (for managing stress, anxiety, depression etc.), pre-marital counselling, managing behavioural addictions, memory training and health intervention through yoga and meditation. Centre for HOPE also conducts Psychometric Assessments (aptitude assessments for career guidance and/or career advancement, academic achievement, personality assessments etc.). 8. Central Research Laboratory

9. Centre for Innovation, Incubation & Entrepreneurship (CII & E)

The Centre for Innovation Incubation & Entrepreneurship (CIIE) of PSG College of Arts & a Science, Coimbatore instituted in 2007, fosters entrepreneurial spirit and innovation among students and the public. CII & E encompasses the Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC), Institution & Innovation Council (IIC), and PSGCAS Business Incubation Centre. These divisions provide skill - based training, support for innovative business ideas, and provide mentorship for Startups. CII & E organizes workshops, seminars, and competitions, creating a vibrant entrepreneurial ecosystem. CII & E aims to link academia, financial institutions, industries and mentors to promote creativity, business start-ups, and sustainable growth for global welfare.

10. Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC)

The Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) started in 2012, aims at invoking and nurturing entrepreneurial spirit among students and the general public. The cell meticulously plans and executes skill-based trainings and Entrepreneurship Development Programmes (EDPs) for heterogeneous groups of entrepreneurship aspirants from within the campus as well as for the public. The cell strives to establish a healthy entrepreneurial eco-system for generating innovative business ideas and provide pre-incubation support to explore the feasibility of those ideas. Periodically conducting workshops, seminars and interactions with entrepreneurs, investors, and professionals are organized to create a pool of mentors for student innovators. The cell has widespread networks with national & state level entrepreneurship development organizations and has been receiving funding support for organizing Entrepreneurship promotion activities for students and public.

11. Institution & Innovation Council (IIC)

The Ministry of Education & initiative, PSGCAS Institution & Innovation Council (IIC) was started in November 2018 to promote innovation in the campus. The council has a faculty members-led students & team to conduct various innovation and entrepreneurship-oriented activities prescribed by the Central MIC (MoE & Innovation Council) in a time-bound fashion. IIC mediates to organize innovation workshops, contests, hackathons, idea competition, mini-challenges etc., in collaboration with industries.

12. PSGCAS Business Incubation Centre

The PSGCAS Business Incubation Centre started in 2019 envisions developing entrepreneurial culture in the campus and creating an entrepreneurial eco-system in the society. The centre houses Idea lab, maker & space, tinkering lab, training hall and co-incubation workspace in about 10000 sq. ft. The mission of the centre is to incubate, handhold and promote creativity and innovation, instill entrepreneurial mind-set, offer support for establishing business and value addition through developing products and services. Academic laboratories which are pre-incubation facilities, house smaller innovations and mentor the ideas for fulfilling academic requirements. Those ideas are nurtured and supported for funding support for scale up and start-up promotion at Business Incubation centre. The objectives are: to promote entrepreneurial culture, to initiate business start-ups, to mentor business incubatees, and to build a vibrant Innovation & Startup eco-system by linking academia, funding agencies, industries and other supportive collaborations.

The centre offers computer-assisted language learning facilities to enhance the communication skills of the students. It also houses the EDUSAT studio to uplink live transmission of classes throughout the country.

Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates “ragging” within or outside the institution shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 shall also be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other education.

Attendance

The College follows Bharathiar University - attendance guidelines; attendance is considered semester-wise. If a student is absent for one or more hours in a session (Forenoon OR Afternoon) he/she will lose attendance for half-a-day.

Evaluation Pattern

1. All students are assessed through Continuous assessment (CA) and Comprehensive Examinations (CE).
2. Continuous assessment (CA) shall be conducted twice a semester. CAI after completion of half the syllabus and CAII after completion of the entire syllabus.
3. Comprehensive examinations (Theory and practical) shall be conducted twice a year, in November/December and in April/May.
4. Under Continuous Assessment pattern system, the students are assessed through periodical tests, assignments, quiz, etc continuously
5. All Pass/fail percentage in the course shall be governed by the regulations in force at the time of their appearances.
6. The Student must get a minimum of (40%) in CE and (40%) in CE and CA put together at UG level and (50%) in CE and (50%) in CE and CA put together at PG Level.

Comprehensive Exam (CE)

Students of Undergraduate classes can write their comprehensive examinations either in English or Tamil. Undergraduate students can write exams in Tamil by submitting prior requests at the time of paying examination fees and requests submitted later will not be entertained. Postgraduate students are not permitted to write their examinations in Tamil

Exams taken prior to the date of malpractice stands cancelled and He/She will not be permitted to write the rest of the examination Semester, including Supplementary and additional Subjects.

Rules & Regulations

Though the above penalties are stipulated for various malpractice cases, it is left to the discretion of the Examination Committee to affirm, reduce and enhance the penalty depending upon the nature of malpractice.

Provision For Re Total :

1. Candidates can apply for re-total to the Controller of Examinations, remitting the prescribed fees within 10 calendar days from the date of publication of results.
2. If the marks obtained in re total is higher than the marks awarded earlier , A revised mark statement will be issued

Provision for Revaluation

1. Candidates can apply for revaluation of the answer scripts to the Controller of Examinations, remitting the prescribed fees within 10 calendar days from the date of publication of results.
2. If the marks obtained in re valuation is higher than the marks awarded earlier , A revised mark statement will be issued

Improvement Exam : (UG & PG)

Candidates who have passed in Examination / Examinations of UG/PG programmes may be permitted to write Comprehensive Examination / Examinations of the Programme / Programmes Only once under regulations and syllabus in force then, with a view to improve their performance in CE exam failing which the previous mark will be consider for award of degree. Such candidates shall not apply for their degree certificates in the convocations held in between. Such reappearances shall be made at the examination(s) conducted in the College in the next two semesters.

System of transparency in examination

1. Photo copies of evaluated answer scripts will be given to the students on their request after they pay the prescribed fees within 10 calendar days from the date of publication of results.
2. In consultation with the subject expert/ tutor Students shall decide to apply for retotal/ revaluation

Additional supplementary examination

To provide an opportunity to the final UG,PG and Add-on career oriented course students to complete their programmes in the same year itself and to help them for vertical mobility, additional supplementary comprehensive examination is conducted

Special supplementary examination

Special supplementary examination will be conducted in June / July every year, to facilitate the students who have failed in only one subject from first to five semesters in case of UG, from first to third semester in case of PG and first to Ninth Semester in case of MSc Software Systems (five year integrated), to complete the programme in the same year itself.

Rules & Regulations

Extra courses

Candidates desirous of qualifying themselves in courses other than those prescribed for the programmes can appear for the Comprehensive Examinations in those extra subjects with prior permission. Attendance is not compulsory for those subjects. The performance of the candidates in those extra courses will not be taken into account for classification of major and supporting courses.

Library rules
