“The Destiny of a Nation is decided in its classrooms” – PSG College of Arts and Science has proved this prophetic statement with conviction by emerging as one of the premier institutions of higher learning in this country. The college has a long-standing academic tradition of excellence in research and scholarship. This is coupled with the most advanced facilities for the pursuit of higher learning. The college has a team of experienced and efficient faculty and our academic programmes are challenging and updated. Forty Two Undergraduate and Twenty Eight Postgraduate programmes, Five PG Diploma and One Diploma programmes are offered and many of them are unique. M.Phil and Ph.D programmes are offered in Twenty One Disciplines.

The college was identified as a College with Potential for Excellence by UGC in October 2004. It is one among 47 colleges in the country, 8 in the State and the only one in Bharathiar University area to get such a recognition in 2004. ABOUT THE LIBRARY

PSG College of Arts and Science was established with the dawn of the country’s Independence under the PSG & Sons Charities Trust on 11.08.1947 to fulfill the visionary words of the Founder Trustee Shri. P.S. Govindaswamy Naidu “To serve society through development of education industry and the needy and poor”.

The Library came into being along with the establishment of the College. With the recurring grants from the Government, generous Management contribution and UGC the Library has been steadily and systematically equipped. The Library had been functioning on the first floor of the College Administration Building till the year 1970.

In the year 1971, the Management dedicated a separate Library Building with two floors to collect, organise and disseminate information and also to provide quality Library services to its users effectively and efficiently.

Management has constructed additional building and now the library built up area is 24200 Sq. feet with the seating capacity for about 400 readers. It is well stocked and presently has a collection of over 1, 20,000 volumes on different subjects.

Latest publications in the fields of Life Sciences, Physical Sciences, Chemical Sciences, Business Studies, Economics, Humanities and Social Sciences are continuously added to the collection to equip student with a wide range of academic materials.

The Library also subscribes about 250 journals of national and international repute. Various E-Resources like SCOPUS, EBSCO, PROQUEST, N-LIST, CMIE Prowess, CAPITALINE and IndiaStat.com are subscribed for the benefit of users All Prominent national dailies are also subscribed in the library. The College Library is fully automated and provides user services through computer and has Wi Fi facility.

ABOUT THE SEMINAR

In tune with the expansion of information and knowledge, especially during the last decade, new issues are cropping up in the field of Library and Information Sciences. The foremost one is the shifting of content controls from publishers to aggregators. Due to this, libraries may lose the tag of repository of knowledge. Hence, Library Professionals are needed to be associated with selecting quality content of their users. In other words, the job profile of Librarians are changing, challenging and becoming increasingly techno-savvy. To meet them, therefore, the Librarians have to do proper selection of quality content from web resources and do value addition before giving the same to the users. Value addition is highly important in the digital age. The Librarians, by equipping themselves could become nodal points in their institutions.

To update the skills of Library and Information Science Professionals this Seminar is being organized. The specific objectives of the seminar are :

- 1. To assess the changing needs and the choices available for users.

- 2. To examine the access to online electronic resources and the issues and challenges pertaining to it (Supply side).**
- 3. To gauge the Emerging trends in the technological up-gradation of Libraries and the new skills required for Library Professionals (Management dimension).**
